

This Month's tips look at a couple of features that came from other users in the past two years.

Users had requested a way to print out which GCodes were assigned to which listings. To accommodate this request, Goomzee<sup>®</sup> added the "**Print All**" button on the My Campaigns screen in the lower right hand corner of the page. When you click this button, it will allow you to print a list of your GCodes, which properties are assigned to each code, and a few vital bits of information about each property.

The print screen defaults to print the QR codes assigned to each code. However, you can turn off the QR code printing by closing the Print dialogue, un-click the "Show QR Codes" box, then print the list.

This screen to also allows you to download all your QR Codes as a zip file, or individually, so you can access them on your computer and use them in other marketing materials. However, there is also another way you can access your QR codes, which is described next.

While on the My Campaigns screen, click the "**Get My QR Codes**" button. Once you've clicked the button, you will be prompted to download a zip file containing all the codes. Once the QR codes have downloaded, you now have access to use them in any of your marketing materials.
